A Sliding doors:

Flush pulls and matching hardware in polished nickel finish.

B Cupboard doors:

Flush ring handle in polished nickel, door hardware including roller bolt, hinges and magnetic catch.

C Windows:

Sash and casement window fittings throughout.

D, E, F Double rebated doors:

Classic polished nickel knob handles with co-ordinated hardware including hinges, latches, door stops and flush bolts.

G Wine store door:

Classic lever handle on rose in polished nickel finish, with all matching hardware.

H Entrance door:

Banham nightlatch and deadlocks, letterplate and inner tidy, centre door knob.

I Bi-folding internal doors:

Flush pulls in polished nickel finish with matching hardware including hinges, flush bolts, door stops and magnetic catches.

J Dressing room cabinet doors and drawers:

Classic reeded drop handles in polished nickel finish.

K Cabinet doors:

Reeded glass ball and polished nickel cupboard knobs.
